

ST. THERESA OF LISIEUX
CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL ADVISORY COUNCIL
CONSTITUTION

The purpose of this Constitution is to identify the various rules and regulations governing the St. Theresa of Lisieux Catholic High School Advisory Council (the “Catholic School Council”). These rules and regulations shall consist of the most current version of the following documents:

1. The General By-law of the Catholic School Council.
2. Ontario Regulations 612/00 and 613/00.
3. Mission Statements, Vision Statements, Values, Goals and Code of Ethics of:
 - (a) the York Catholic District School Board;
 - (b) St. Theresa of Lisieux Catholic High School; and
 - (c) the St. Theresa of Lisieux Catholic School Advisory Council.
4. Charters of the following Standing Committees:
 - (a) Faith Committee;
 - (b) Finance Committee;
 - (c) Community Relations Committee; and
 - (d) Social Committee.

This Constitution may be reviewed at the discretion of the Catholic School Council, but in any event must take place within a period of four years of the date of the last review. The procedures in Section 13 of the most current version of the General By-Law of the Catholic School Council shall be followed when making amendments to this Constitution.
